Attention: The top 3 place finishers from any Junior Regional qualify for Fargo, as well as top 3 for FILA Cadets. Otherwise this is the only other tournament to qualify you for the National Teams. If you cannot make the tournament and wish to petition on to one of the teams, you must have a written petition on file with the State Chairman accompanied by a check in the amount of \$50 prior to the tournament. The \$50 is non-refundable. The State Chairman and the Coaching Staff will rule on your petition. Do not bother petitioning unless you have a valid reason. (Example: a debilitating injury)

Remember that Juniors must wrestle in a qualifier to be eligible to compete in this tournament. A freestyle tournament may count as the qualifier for both styles. ***All Juniors intending on competing for the VA USA National Team at the Junior National Championships in Fargo, ND must bring a check written to "VA USA Wrestling" in the sum of \$100 as a deposit on the uniform package.***

Wrestlers need to have a red and a blue singlet.

We will have singlets and other merchandise available to purchase through "All-American Wrestling Supply".

Medical Forms: You must have a "VA/USA Medical Form" filled out for any skin condition.

Weigh-in for Greco Only and those wrestling BOTH STYLES. Those wrestling both styles do not have to weigh-in again (**If you withdraw from the Greco Tournament you must weigh in again for the Freestyle Tournament unless cleared by the tournament medical staff**). You must weigh-in when called. No extensions or extra time to make weight. Travel early to avoid traffic.

Registration for all wrestlers (even if you weighed-in on Saturday)

Weigh-in for freestyle only

You must weigh-in when called. No extensions or extra time to make weight. Travel early to avoid traffic.

\$30.00 both styles.

CHECKS: Make payable to "VA/USA WRESTLING"

ELIGIBILITY: *You must be enrolled in grades 9 thru 12 and be a resident of Virginia. **Note that Cadets who are in high school may wrestle in the Junior State Tournaments as well as the Cadet State Tournaments***

ADMISSION: \$5.00 adults/\$3.00 students EACH DAY

WEIGHTS: Plus 3 pounds allowance
You must wrestle the weight that you wish to qualify for the National Team.

Junior (born 9/1/86 and after, plus enrolled in grades 9-12)
98, 105, 112, 119, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 152, 160, 171, 189, 215, 275.

The athlete has only four consecutive years to compete in the Junior Division once his/her class begins the ninth grade.

- AWARDS:**
1. Medals to the top three places
 2. Top one, two, or three places may qualify for the national team (Depends on the size of the weight class)
 3. Wild card positions filled by the staff
 4. Outstanding Wrestler Award (each style)
 5. Club Championship Award (each style)
 6. Joe Pyanoe Sportsmanship Award (each style)

DIRECTIONS TO HENRICO HIGH SCHOOL:

Henrico High School is located in Henrico County, just north of the city of Richmond. Traveling on I-95, north of the I-95/I-64 interchange and south of the I-95/I-295 interchange.
